

**INTERSOS** is an independent non-profit humanitarian organization committed to assist the victims of natural disasters and armed conflicts. Its activities are based on the principles of solidarity, justice, human dignity, equality of rights and opportunities, and respect for diversity and coexistence, paying special attention to the most vulnerable and unprotected people.

**INTERSOS** first started to work in Somalia in 1992. It immediately assisted 37,000 refugees that in the previous months had left their land in search of food and a safe living environment. From that point forth, Intersos has operated in various regions in central-southern Somalia (Bay-Bakol, Ghedo, Lower and Middle Shebelle, Lower Giuba, Benadir) principally with activities focusing on reconstruction or reactivation of health and sanitation structures, locating drinking water, and agricultural development.

**INTERSOS** has implemented several projects in the education, health, water and sanitation and protection sectors in Bay, Middle and Lower Shabelle regions, funded by UNICEF, UNOCHA, EC, Italian Cooperation, Global Fund, WFP and private donors.

In Kenya **INTERSOS** decided to support WOFAK (Women Fighting AIDS in Kenya), on the base of credibility, efficiency and reliability of the activities that they were following in the slums, on this problematic issue, such as HIV/AIDS. Since that **INTERSOS** has implemented several projects in the nutrition, raising awareness on HIV/AIDS, health, and protection sectors in the slum of Kayole and Soweto and in the northern district of Kisumu, in Homabay
